



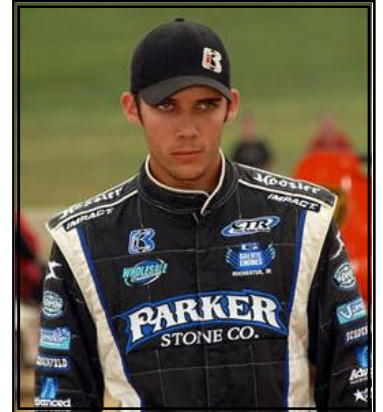

## August Racing was Hot! Hot! Hot!

If you've been to very many POWRi races this month, you've seen the blue & white #39 midget getting the checkered flag several times. The driver of that car is 21 year old Bryan Clauson. In fact, during our Western Swing, Bryan won three of the first four feature events (the rain won the other one) and then he went on to win "the big one" at the Belleville, Ks. Midget Nationals.

Bryan is a bundle of talent and experience. He started racing Quarter Midgets in California at age 5, moving to Indiana and 600cc Micros when he was 12 years old and then on to Sprint Car racing at age 14. Currently he races Midgets, Sprints and Silver Crown cars. He probably runs 120 races a year. That's a lot of racing.

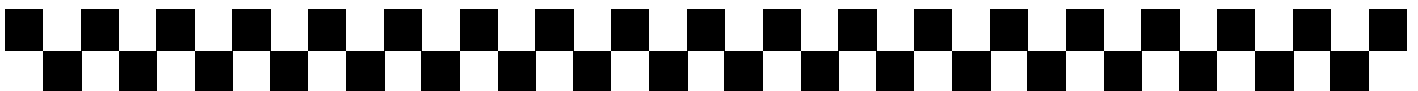


As far as his future in racing goes, Bryan's goal is to be good enough and consistent enough to earn a living racing. He says he really is not too concerned with getting to Indy or NASCAR (although he says that would probably be fun too) but just doing a lot of what he does best, driving and winning. I think he is managing to do that very well.

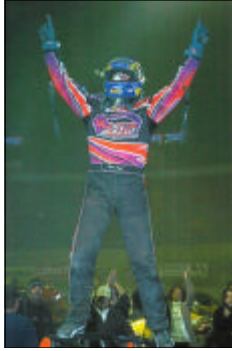
Bryan's advice to up and coming young drivers is to do it because you love it, not just to be a "NASCAR Star". He says the sacrifices in money, time and life style wouldn't be worth it unless it is a "love affair" between you and driving that race car. His dad, mom and younger sister totally agree and are in it with him for the long haul.

When I talk to a POWRi person I ask them for a little quirky story that sticks in their mind as a funny or embarrassing, or memorable moment at the track. Bryan told me about an instance from a couple of years ago and his first experience with a fire in his racer. He was racing at Angell Park Speedway and had 'one of those special occasions' with his car. The car then caught on fire and Bryan bailed and rolled. When the rescuers came running up to him, before they could say a word, Bryan yelled, "Am I OK? Am I OK?" The responder stopped cold and said, "We're supposed to ask you that question!"

Bryan enjoys racing with POWRi and meeting the fans. He says he and his guys have yet to leave a POWRi race without talking about how much fun they had. Of course with his track record this season, taking the money home is always the best fun. Stop by the # 39 Pit after the races and chat with Bryan. Tell him how much fun WE have watching him drive.

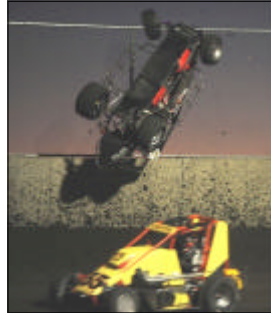

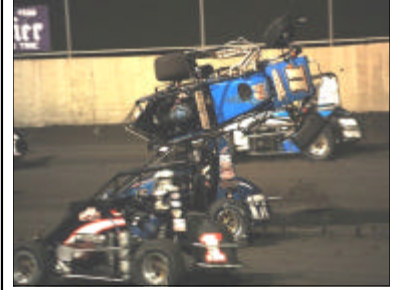
