POWRi 360 Winged Sprint Car Desert Series Host Track & POWRI 360 WSCDS Responsibilities

Host Track Responsibilities for the 2022 Racing Season for POWRi 360 WSCDS;

- A. Host Track is solely responsible for the Purse Payout, with the only exception being for Heat Race Winners. Sponsors that help raise the funds, may be included for all track Press Releases as well as announced in conjunction with POWRi 360 WSCDS Sponsors, not limited to Marketing Partnerships POWRi 360 WSCDS may have for select races.
- B. Tracks will have a set Pit Pass Price for all Sprint Car Drivers that shall not be less than POWRi 360 WSCDS drivers Admission Fees, Non-Members may be Charged More for Pit Passes than POWRi Members.
- C. POWRi 360 WSCDS Officials will not be charged Admittance to track or Pits and shall receive Pit Passes for the POWRi Shows to properly run the series at no cost.
- D. Aside from Pit Pass and Transponder Rental no other fees to race may be applied against any Member of POWRi 360 WSCDS.
- E. All Tracks must have Transponder and Scoring Loops
- F. All Tracks Must have RaceCeiver Communication to drivers.
- G. All Tracks Must have adequate push vehicles to keep the show moving as well as to help cars fire off to Pack, Hot Lap, Race. Please note that not all Cars are Required to use Track Push Vehicles, however not all drivers have their own push vehicles to properly start their cars. Following a Red Flag, it will be all handson deck to get cars started and going in the timeliest manner possible.
- H. All Tracks must have a set of scales and a designated area for the checking of weight.
- I. POWRi 360 WSCDS will perform Pill Draw and Post on My Race Pass as well as give the Host Track the Lineups as soon as they are available for Posting.
- J. Host Track Officials shall work with POWRi Officials to ensure a safe and competitive racing atmosphere that is mutually beneficial to Host Track as well as POWRi Series While following WSCDS Rules and Race Procedures.
- K. Host Track may elect or request that POWRi 360 WSCDS mudpack the track but must allow adequate time with another class or series to pack to allow POWRi 360 WSCDS Cars to clean excess mud off the cars prior to Hot laps so as not to prematurely damage cars and components.
- L. A Hot lap session of no less than two (2) and no more than three (3) laps shall be ran prior to the green flag in all races so drivers may assess track conditions and know the track.
- M. Host Track Shall have an Intermission of a minimum timeframe as to allow POWRi Top 8 redraw to take place on the front stretch in front of the fans. At which time Drivers will Choose a frisbee with a number, sign it, and throw it to the fans. If one of the Top 8 win the main event that Frisbee Owner will win a Free POWRi T-Shirt.
- N. Following the Main Event Conclusion POWRi would like to invite the Frisbee Holder Down to the Winners Circle to take part in Winner Photographs if Host Track Insurance will allow.
- O. Payout Shall Occur each night by Host Track in form of either Cash or Check to drivers/owners.
- P. Host Track shall allow POWRi 360 WSCDS to have a Merchandise Trailer in the area of Grandstand Admission Holders to sell POWRi 360 WSCDS Merchandise and POWRi Member Driver Apparel at no additional fee to the Series or Drivers. Other Vendors to include POWRi Member Drivers and Crew may be charged for the privilege to set up a merchandise booth, trailer, or table for the purpose of selling goods as per Host Track regulations and agreements.
- Q. POWRi 360 WSCDS shall act as a Turnkey Operation and will operate independently while obeying Host Track Safety Rules and Regulations.
- R. Host Track will not Pay POWRi 360 WSCDS any Sanctioning Fees, Nor Shall they pay any POWRi Official for having a Race Program.
- S. Any money Collected for Admission from Grandstands or Pits Passes except for Purse shall remain 100% in the hands of the Host Track.
- T. In The Event of a live Stream/Pay Per View that the Host Track has set-up or is responsible for then the monetary funds from that shall remain between the hosting Streaming/Pay Per View Channel and the Host Track.

POWRi 360 Winged Sprint Car Desert Series Host Track & POWRI 360 WSCDS Responsibilities

- U. Cancelations outside of the acts of God; Fire, Extreme Wind, Flood, Rain, Tornado, Hurricane, Lightning, Viral Pandemic, prior to a race event that cancels the entire program have the option by Host track and POWRi 360 WSCDS to be rescheduled at a latter date. All Other Cancelations by either party shall result in the cancelation party owing the non-cancelation party no more or less than \$3,000.00 in lost revenue from marketing and time for event preparations.
- V. Rainouts, or any act of God that prevents the Race Program from concluding shall fall under POWRi 360 WSCDS Rainout policy found in Race Procedures.
- W. Host Track is responsible for their own Advertising, POWRi 360 WSCDS will advertise for the Race Program on all Major Social Media Sites, POWRi Website, POWRi 360 WSCDS website, My Race Pass, Marketing Material with schedules, and the Race Program Prior to Event.

POWRI 360 WSCDS Responsibilities;

- a. POWRi 360 WSCDS Officials shall consist of Director of Competition, Technical Director, Director of Communications, Series CFO, and Series Marketing Representative.
- b. Director of Communications will be posting on Social Media Platforms as well as taking a place in the booth to facilitate communications between Host Track Race Control and Director of Competition.
- c. Director Of Competition will be in the infield monitoring the Cone for Restarts, watching the track conditions, monitoring Competition, and performing Tech Inspections with Host Track Crew at Scales and after with Technical Director. Director of Competition will work closely with track officials and management to put on the best show possible while maintaining mutual beneficial goals for host track and series.
- d. Technical Director will act as Series Pit Steward as well as performing final Tech Inspections Post Race, During Main event they will also take up a position in the infield to help monitor race conditions with Competition Director.
- e. Series CFO will be at Series Pill Draw and take charge of all POWRi monies for the event, from both pill draw and merchandise sales, following Pill Draw Series CFO will then be in the Merchandise Trailer taking payments and selling merchandise with the Series Marketing Representative.
- f. Series Marketing Representative will meet with Series Drivers and collect with a receipt any Driver Apparel that drivers wish to offer for sale in the Merchandise Trailer. Series Marketing Representative will then sale official POWRi 360 WSCDS Merchandise along with Driver Apparel in the Merchandise Trailer during the scheduled event. At the conclusion unsold Driver Apparel will be returned with a receipt to drivers and Series CFO will have made out a check for sold apparel to be delivered back to the driver post event.
- g. POWRi Directors will meet each race day no more than three (3) hours prior to scheduled race event with Host track staff for updates and changes as well as to finalize itinerary of events.
- h. POWRi 360 WSCDS Officials will conduct technical inspection following the main event separately from the Host Track except for Scales.
- i. POWRi 360 WSCDS will pay for or purchase Winners Trophies either through the Host Track or from another vendor if the Host Track does not usually have trophies.
- j. Aside from Trophy Purchase no POWRi 360 WSCDS Official shall pay the Host track or any Representative of the Host Track in any monetary form solely for hosting a Race Program.
- k. If POWRi 360 WSCDS brings a Streaming/ Pay Per View Channel to a Racing Facility that otherwise does not offer this service Monetary Proceeds shall be divided as follows; 25% to Host Track, 25% to POWRi 360 WSCDS, and 50% to Streaming/Pay Per View Channel. Funds from Streaming/Pay Per View Channel shall come From the Streaming/Pay Per View Channel to both Host Track as well as POWRi 360 WCSDS.
- I. POWRi 360 WSCDS Merchandise Sales are strictly that of the series, Host Tracks must agree to the use of their logo on any merchandise that is being sold. Schedules are not to be sold and agreement to hold a race is an implied agreement for track name and logo to appear on all schedules.
- m. POWRi 360 WSCDS is owned and operated by G10 Promotions LLC under authorization of Performance Open Wheel Racing Incorporated (POWRi).
