



## POWRi Lightning Sprint National Point Structure

### POINTS

- A. All competitors will start each race season with zero points.
- B. National Points will start March 1<sup>st</sup> and will end October 31<sup>st</sup>.
- C. Points will be awarded only to registered POWRi members and are non-transferable.
- D. POWRi points will be given for each sanctioned event in the following manner:
  - a. Feature
    - 1st 300
    - 2nd 290
    - 3rd 280
    - 4th 270
    - 5th 260
    - 6th 250
    - 7th 240
    - 8th 230
    - 9th 220
    - 10th 210
    - 11th 200
    - 12th 190
    - 13<sup>th</sup> 180
    - 14th 170
    - 15th 160
    - 16th 150
    - 17th 140
    - 18th 130
    - 19th 120
    - 20th 110
    - 21st thru last 100
- E. Any car/driver not transferring to the main event that runs the semi-feature will receive 50 points each. No semi-feature points will be awarded to any car/driver that transfers to the main event from the semi-feature.
- F. In the event of a rain out after a feature field has been set, all drivers in the feature field will be awarded 150 points each. Any driver not transferring to the feature event that runs the semi-feature will receive 50 points each.
- G. In an event that there is not a minimum field of 15 cars, there will be a sliding points system in place. Each position will decrease by 10 points. Example: If 5 cars enter, the winner will get 250 points instead of the 300 points.
- H. At the end of the year, POWRi will take the best 15 races for each person for their year-end total points. Ties will be broken by the number of wins, then second places, etc.
