

KKM Giveback Classic Format - 2025 <u>Jr. Sprint</u>

Prelim Nights

Pill Draw

- Drivers will pill draw for their Qualifying/Heat Race Group.

Qualifying

- Qualifying will be 3 laps and take place during Hot Laps.
- Drivers will only Qualify against their Heat Race.
- Qualifying Points will be awarded in each group as follows: 1-50, 2-48, 3-46, 4-44, 5-42, 6-40, 7-38, 8-36, 9-34, 10-32.

Heat Races

- Heat Races will be lined up with a four-car inversion, based on Qualifying Times.
 Drivers outside of the inversion will line straight up, starting with the 5th position.
- The POWRi Passing Point system will be used for Heat Races.
- Top 16 in combined qualifying and passing points will advance to the A Feature. (Point Tie Breaker being Fastest Qualifying Time)
- Remaining drivers will be placed in a Semi-Feature based on car count.

Semi-Features

- The number of semi-features and lower mains will depend on the final car count.
- Semi-feature transfers will depend on the final car count.

Feature

- Top 16 in combined points will line straight up, with the Semi-Feature transfer cars lining up behind.
- 20 cars to start Prelim Feature.
- Top 4 finishers will lock into Saturday's Feature.

Saturday Night

Top 6 in accumulated finishing points from Thursday and Friday prelim features will be locked into Saturday's A-Feature.

Semi -Features – Drivers not locked in will be placed in semi features lined up based on their total finishing points from Thursday and Friday night's shows. The number of transfers in semi-features is dependent on car count.

20 cars to start Championship Feature.

Saturday format subject to change based on final car count.
