Membership Requirements

- a. No person shall be discriminated against because of sex, race, religion, or national origin.
 - i. POWRi Mandatory Membership:
 1. Members will earn POWRi championship points, be eligible for any contingency awards if all requirements are met and have coverage under the secondary insurance plan.

Points & Point Fund

- a. All competitors will start each race season with zero points.
- b. Points will be awarded only to registered POWRi members and are nontransferable.
- c. POWRi points will be given for each sanctioned event in the following manner:
 - i. Feature:
 1. 1st - 300
 2. 2nd - 290
 3. 3rd - 280
 4. 4th - 270
 5. 5th - 260
 6. 6th - 250
 7. 7th - 240
 8. 8th - 230
 9. 9th - 220
 10. 10th - 210
 11. 11th - 200
 12. 12th - 190
 13. 13th - 180
 14. 14th - 170
 15. 15th - 160
 16. 16th - 150
 17. 17th - 140
 18. 18th - 130
 19. 19th - 120
 20. 20th - 110
 21. 21st thru last - 100
 - ii. Any car/driver not transferring to the main event that runs the semi-feature will receive 50 points each. No semi-feature points will be awarded to any car/driver that transfers to the main event from the semi-feature.
 - iii. In the event of a rain out after a feature field has been set, all drivers in the feature field will be awarded 150 points each. Any driver not transferring to the feature event that runs the semi-feature will receive 50 points each.
- d. A point fund and other awards will be presented during the annual Awards Banquet to be held at the completion of the race season. To be eligible to receive an award from the point's fund, a member must participate in at least 80% of the completed events during the season.

Provisionals

- a. To be eligible for a provisional, the driver must be a current member at the time the provisional is to be taken.
 - i. Drivers who are current members are eligible for (3) three provisional starts per season.
 - ii. To qualify for a provisional, the driver must be in the top twenty in driver points at the time the provisional is to be taken and must have registered to participate in the event at which the provisional is to be used.
- b. The eligible and qualified driver that is highest in the current driver point standings will be the first entitled to a provisional. If that driver elects not to use a provisional, the eligible and qualified driver that is next highest in the driver point standings will then be entitled to a provisional. A provisional will pay the car's finish position minus last place money.
- c. Prior to the first two races of the current season, provisionals will be based on the season ending driver points from the previous season. After the first two races of the current season, provisionals will be based on the current driver point standings.

Rookie of the Year

- a. To qualify for Rookie of the Year, a participant must be approved by the Series Director. The definition of "rookie" will be determined by the Series Director.
